MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR: BIG THINGS ARE HAPPENING IN 2019



In the first half of 2019, we experienced a noticeable expansion of business with our existing customer base, the adoption of ductile iron poles by many new utilities, and the successful qualification of both of our manufacturing locations by one of the Nation's largest investor-owned utilities, who is planning significant usage. I want to recognize the continued hard work of our production and sales teams for the growth and improvement we have achieved so far this year.

There are several major customer opportunities nearing the point of conversion. To prepare for this, in the second half of 2019, we are making significant capital investment in equipment that will increase capacity and improve quality, both in Ohio and Utah. Lyntegar Tornado Recovery

The Midwest, Plains and West Texas have seen a rash of severe weather throughout the 1st quarter. Lyntegar Electrical Cooperative was one organization that was hit especially hard “having 40 transmission poles down at their Draw substation and numerous distribution poles” (KCBD News, May 5, 2019) as the result of a storm in early May. To help support their recovery effort, the MP team was able to deliver poles from both our Coshocton and Provo facilities within just a few days of the event. TECH TALK PIN JOINT IMPROVEMENT

At McWane Poles we are always looking for ways to improve the safety and reliability of our product. One of our latest efforts focuses around the slip joints on our poles. In May of this year we started using Elco’s Tap-Flex® thread-forming structural screws to tie our pole sections together. Doing this has allowed us to reduce the risk of rivet nut slippage while maintaining the overall strength of the product. TOP SECTION NAME PLATE

Information on the plate includes Serial Number, Structure Number, Height, Class and Date of Manufacture. So, the next time you are in the field, take a look at the two-piece poles to see another improvement to our product.

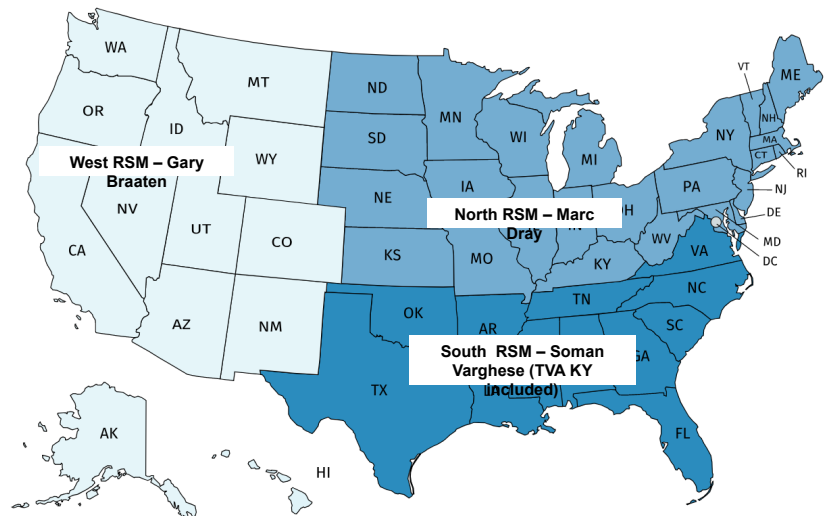
